The **Alger County Animal Shelter** serves 10,000 people. In **2021**, it reported a placement rate of 100% of dogs and 99% of cats

In 2022, ACAS took in over 150 animals and adopted them into their forever homes and reunited lost pets with their families. In just the last few months, the Shelter adopted over 30 animals into great homes. Our Adoption Committee takes immense care in matching up potential pet owners with the animals and their unique personalities.

The Shelter provides many services to our community working with police agencies taking in lost pets or working with the community itself in finding a lost pet and reuniting them with their family.

The Shelter is completely sustainable on donations and we thank our community, near and far, for the wonderful support in saving lives and getting these animals into terrific homes.

The Shelter has reached over 80,000 Facebook supporters and thousands of donors inside and outside of our community. These supporters donate, adopt, and spread the word of our animals available for adoption. The Alger County Animal Shelter offers a variety of services to our community

1. A safe haven for unwanted or lost pets.
2. Finds forever homes for orphaned cats and dogs.
3. In 2022 the Shelter is at 100 percent no kill and is one of the top Shelters in the State.
4. Reunites owners with lost pets through a variety of resources.
5. Provides training and socialization while pets wait for their forever homes.
6. Morning, afternoon and night crews ensuring animals get a lot of exercise and socialization. There are three to four daily shifts caring for the animals. The staff and volunteers work countless hours ensuring the animals are well taken care of. No Shelter animal sits in their kennels for extended periods of time.
7. Workers and volunteers know each animal intimately. Each animal receives individual care and attention.
8. Provides vet care for each animal arriving at the Shelter. Each animal receives the necessary vaccinations and initial treatment.
9. Employment opportunities for the community.
10. Training of youth in the proper handling of animals, animal care, socialization, and exercise and playtime.
11. Is a pretty fun place for people and animals to hang out.
12. Is a fully recognized 501(C)(3)
13. Fully supported by donations from the community, workers and volunteers – inside and outside of our community.
14. Attorney on the board who offers legal advice and direction.
15. Community support through donations, volunteering.
16. The Alger County Animal Shelter assists animals from Munising, Grand Marais, AuTrain, Chatham, Eben, Trenary, Traunik, Singleton, Onota Township, (Shelter Bay and Deerton), Highway 13 area, Hiawatha National Forest, and many other outlining areas, which is quite a large area to cover
17. Upkeep of the Shelter building through donations and support of the community. Saving the county in repair/upkeep expenses.
18. One of the top no-kill Shelters in the State of Michigan.

Specific gift: You describe exactly what kind of gift you want to leave to a specific individual or organization and the designated source. If you want to leave a specific dollar amount from a specific source or a particular item, this is the type of bequest you would use.

Residuary gift: This type of bequest is honored after all other bequests have been made, and all debts, expenses and taxes have been paid.

Contingent gift: This type of bequest is fulfilled if certain conditions are met. For instance, if your primary beneficiary does not survive you, you can indicate your next choice through a contingent bequest.
